Job Title: Crew Leader

Position Summary:

Performs direct field supervision of maintenance techs of the Housing Authority of the Sac and Fox Nation. Work includes managing a small crew by prioritizing projects, assigning work tasks, using equipment, maintaining records, monitoring work quality and work schedules.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Determine schedules, sequences, and assignments for work activities, based on work priority, quantity of equipment and skill of personnel.
- 2. Inspect and monitor work areas, examine tools and equipment, and provide employee safety training to prevent, detect, and correct unsafe conditions or violations of procedures and safety rules.
- 3. Requisition materials and supplies, such as hand tools, equipment or replacement parts.
- 4. Inspect, test, and measure completed work, using devices such as hand tools or gauges to verify conformance to standards or repair requirements.
- 5. Monitor tool and part inventories and the condition and maintenance of shop to ensure adequate working conditions.
- 6. Perform skilled repair or maintenance operations, using such equipment as hand or power tools, hydraulic presses or shears, or welding equipment
- 7. Assists in the planning and operation of the construction/renovation projects of the Housing Authority Renovation Program for the Tribal Elders/Handicapped Individuals and other housing construction/renovation related activities.
- 8. Maintains progress schedule of each project to assure completion of project within the established time frames.
- 9. Responsible for inspections and the overall quality of work of each project.
- 10. Maintain all costs within the latest approved budget.
- 11. Maintain daily coding to each project.
- 12. All other duties as assigned by Supervisor.

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Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- 1. Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing with crew members, tenants, authority staff, contractors and vendors.
- 2. Knowledge of HUD & other Federal regulations helpful.
- 3. Knowledge of standard construction practices involved with housing construction and renovation.
- 4. Knowledge of lumber, materials, craft tools, equipment and their application to particular projects.
- 5. Knowledge of building codes, fire codes, and safety codes.
- 6. Ability to conduct documented inspections of housing units and to recommend cost effective actions to prolong the usefulness of the housing unit.
- 7. Must have excellent verbal and written skills
- 8. Indian preference shall be used in the review and selection process.
- 9. Professional attire and appearance required
- 10. Trustworthiness
- 11. Professionalism required
- 12. Ability to accept criticism in a non-defensive manner.
- 13. Candidates will be subject to a criminal background check, drug screening and all other required verifications.
